


# **BCC PADDINGTON WARD OFFICE - FITOUT**



#### **SUMMARY**

Blackwood Projects was engaged by Brisbane City Council to undertake the fitout of the new Paddington Ward Office for Councillor Peter Matic. The project was extremely time sensitive and required careful project planning to ensure the timely delivery of the works.

The works comprised demolition and strip-out of the existing office fitout, new partitions and linings, floor coverings, joinery, power and mechanical services, extensive data and network services to meet the BCC ICT requirements; re-building the front entry arrangement to meet AS1428.1 requirements including a new ramp, handrails and door alterations; soft furnishings.
